### **RIDER EDUCATION**

### QUESTION ???

Someone asked me "Why his foot got caught underneath the saddlebag?" I told him that he didn't get his foot up quick enough before he took off. When you come to a stop, the left foot comes down first, the right foot holds the rear brake pedal. Now with traffic, you may creep forward and you need to move your feet as well. If you don't move your feet, they will get caught under the rear saddlebag.

As in street traffic, when traffic comes to a stop, there are vehicles that creep forward. I do not creep forward, in doing so I leave a gap in front of me at least a car length or more. This does two things for me: 1. It gives me an escape route in front of me either to the right or left of the car or truck in front. 2. 95% of the time, the vehicle to the rear of me will give more cushion/space when they see the space that I leave in front of me. I don't rely on the person to my rear to stop, therefore I leave the space cushion/escape route in front of me.

Be careful, Be safe and Keep the shiny side up...




