MAY IS MAINTENANCE

May is Maintenance Month. Every day before we go on a ride, do a maintenance check of the motorcycle? We should all check our motorcycles before we head out for a ride. We should at least do a T-CLOC on our motorcycle. Establish a routine that you will go through before every ride. Start by evaluating the condition of your motorcycle as you walk up to it.





Do a mental T-CLOCS. Look at the tires as you approach (inflated, tread, visible damage). Are there any oily or wet spots on the ground under your bike (where did it come from, is it safe to ride)? And try not to be conservative when you answer these questions of yourself. Keep your eyes open for anything not right. Then, if everything looks okay, gear up. (Of course, you should do a physical T-CLOCS regularly, too, especially before starting a long ride!) A quick check of the motorcycle should take about a couple of minutes.

I definitely check all lights and turn signals. Make sure your GL1800 is maintained and is always in safe rideable condition. Items like brake pads, spark plugs, filters, shocks, bulbs, battery, tools, bearings, oil, repair manual and much more are needed to keep your Honda GL1800 performing at its best for a long time. Most Chapters get together to do maintenance on their motorcycles. Get together laugh, get dirty and have fun doing maintenance.

THE MOLLY-DHARMA RUN STORY



The Molly-Dharma Run (MDR) began in 2007 to benefit MaxFund, a No-Kill Animal Shelter in Denver, Colorado.

This motorcycle ride event was named for Molly-Dharma, a very large, intimidating dog, who had many issues to overcome before she could be adopted, and who was kept at MaxFund for over two and a half years before Kirk Zimmerman adopted her. Ken Mann walked Molly at MaxFund and introduced her to Kirk when she looked, and acted, like she wanted to rip him to pieces. It was touch and go in the beginning, very difficult. Kirk and Ken co-founded this event in Molly's honor for MaxFund in 2007, ... and have done this event every year since. Molly turned 12 in September of 2015, and crossed the Rainbow Bridge in 2016. R.I.P. Ms. Molly-Dharma 9/1/2003 - 8/19/2016

In 2012, the Molly-Dharma Run became a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization in its own right, in order to promote and help other shelters in Denver and Colorado.

Gratitude is what this ride is all about. 


